### TUCSON ENCOURAGES EMPLOYEES AND CITIZENS TO BE ACTIVE IN REPORTING GRAFFITI -

At the Wednesday, Jan. 21, Mayor and Council meeting, the Mayor encouraged residents, utility companies, community groups, and City employees to become proactive when they see graffiti in our community.

In light of this message, we wanted to remind neighborhoods that for those who have smartphones, there is an easy way to report graffiti that you spot when walking, bicycling, or driving around town. Simply download MyTucson, a free app from the iOS App Store or Google Play for Android.

With this app you can snap a picture of any graffiti you see and immediately send it via your smartphone to Graffiti Protective Coatings (GPC), the firm the City has contracted to remove graffiti.
