SUBJECT: Road Improvement Project – Midvale Park Road – Valencia Road to
Irvington Road

Dear Neighbor,

Communication is a key component in creating and preserving partnerships between citizens and the City of Tucson. In keeping with this long-standing commitment, the City of Tucson Department of Transportation (TDOT) is notifying you of an upcoming repaving project that will take place on Midvale Park Road from Valencia Road to Irvington Road.

Southern Arizona Paving and Construction Co., under contract with TDOT, is scheduled to start work on this project in about 15 days. The project will begin with the lowering of manhole covers and water valve covers. This work will take place Monday through Friday from about 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day.

Following the utility lowering work, crews will begin removing the existing asphalt and repaving with new asphalt. This work is scheduled to begin on Monday, March 26, 2018 and will take about three weeks to complete. Crews will work Monday through Friday from about 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day. Following the repaving, crews will raise the manhole covers and water valve covers level with the new asphalt. Please note that this schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or equipment malfunction.

Electronic message boards will be in place to alert motorists of this upcoming work.

There should be no major impacts to your property, but you will see travel lane restrictions and access restrictions when heavy equipment is directly in front of your driveway.
