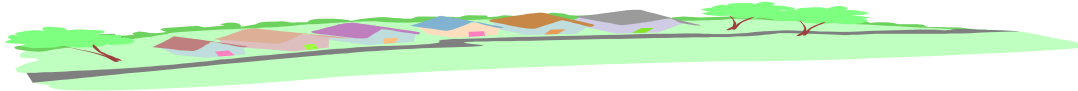

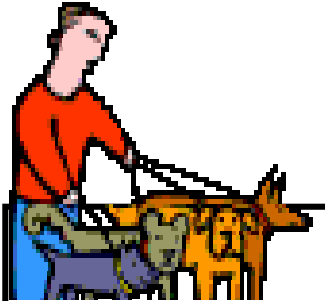


A Walk In the Park

sible pet owner keep your dog leashed and pick up its' gifts. Your fellow park visitors will be thankful.

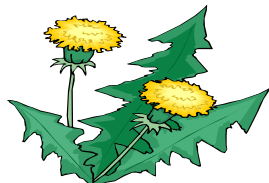
